

## *Needle's Eye, Antelope Canyon #6*

This piece is all color and motion! It is a drawing inspired by Antelope Canyon, located in Arizona. I was able to take a guided photographer's tour of the upper and lower canyons.

I am taken in by the rhythm of the twisting and curving water carved walls. Nature blurs to shapes, forms and lines creating a dynamic design. Realism is pushed to

abstraction. The pale blue orb at the upper center of the drawing is however you may interpret it. Is is the sun? Is it the moon? Or is it the sliver of an eye?

The circle represents totality, wholeness, original perfection, the self, the infinite, eternity, timelessness, cycle of time, and God. "God is a circle whose center is everywhere and whose circumference is nowhere", Hermes Trismegistus.
