

exists to connect SSSF and Associates serving in ministries of Word, sacrament and liturgy, pastoral care & faithcommunity leadership; and to encourage professionalization in these ministries. Through various means the Network assists SSSF to examine issues affecting ministry and the life & work of the Church.

Brief History: School Sisters have been meeting since 1972, looking at the needs of SSSF pastoral ministers and their place in the Church.

After several ministry-related gatherings, S. Joann Brdecka and other School Sisters in pastoral ministries collaborated with Alverno College to convene the "Telesis Seminar on Religious Education & Pastoral Ministries" in June, 1978. At the end of this seminar, the Sisters established an ongoing *Pastoral Ministry Network* with a Steering Committee of six.

The Committee established goals and planned a one-day Network meeting for August, 1979, before the School Sisters' U.S. Regional Assembly; sixty sisters attended. Subsequent Network seminars, usually one or two days in length, have been offered biannually, in evennumbered years. Examples: "Vatican II at 50" (2012); "Francis: The Saint, The Pope, The Franciscan Spirit" (2014); "Peacebuilding: Global & Local" (2016).

Network Membership:

"Ministry" comes from a Latin word for *service*; "pastoral" (from the Latin for *shepherd*) adds the note of tender care, guidance and protection. This Network, originally designed for SSSF and Associates engaged in ministries of the Word, sacrament and liturgy, pastoral care, spiritual direction & faith-community leadership, now welcomes *all interested service-giving persons* as members.
